Privacy Policy

PRIVACY POLICY of DESIGNUP.IT

Pursuant to art. 13 of the European Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter GDPR), and in relation to the personal data of which Designup will become available, we inform you of the following:

1. Data Controller and Data Protection Officer

The data controller is Designup in the person of Ms Danila Cerini with registered office in Via Marco Ferreri n.1 Pineto (TE), email info@designup.it.

2. Types of data collected

During the navigation of the site, the following data may be collected autonomously:

• personal data (name, surname, email address, telephone number, etc...) voluntarily entered by the user by filling in the contact form or sending it by email or telephone or any other form.

Failure by the user to provide certain personal data may prevent the provision of its services.

The user assumes responsibility for the personal data of third parties published or shared through this site and warrants that he/she has the right to communicate or disseminate them, releasing the owner from any liability to third parties.

Cookies

The site designup.it uses cookies to make the user's browsing experience easier and more intuitive: cookies are small strings of text used to store some information that may relate to the user, his preferences or the Internet access device (computer, tablet or cell phone) and are used primarily to adapt the operation of the site to the user's expectations, offering a more personalized browsing experience and storing the choices made previously.

Below are the types of cookies the site makes use of:

Technical cookies

These are necessary for navigation and to facilitate access and use of the site by the user and are used by the supplier to provide the service requested by the customer and allow the safe and efficient use of the site.

Data provided by the user

As indicated above, the optional, explicit and voluntary sending of electronic mail to the addresses indicated on this site involves the subsequent acquisition of the sender's address, necessary to respond to requests, and any other personal data included in the message.

3. Purpose of data processing

The processing of data collected is aimed at creating statistics and sending communications, offers and quotes via email, telephone or other means provided by the user.

4. Data retention

The data collected will be stored for a period of time not exceeding the achievement of the purposes for which they are processed ("principle of limitation of conservation", art.5, GDPR) and / or for the time necessary for legal and contractual obligations. The verification of the obsolescence of the data stored in relation to the purposes for which they were collected is carried out periodically.

5. Modalities of treatment

The personal data directly or indirectly provided by you will be treated confidentially by adopting appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, modification or destruction of Personal Data.

The treatment is carried out by computer and / or telematic tools, with organizational methods and logic closely related to the purposes indicated. In addition to the Data Controller, in some cases, categories of people in charge of the organization of the site (administrative, commercial, marketing, legal, system administrators) or external subjects (such as third party technical service providers, postal couriers, hosting providers, IT companies, communication agencies) also appointed, if necessary, as Data Processors by the Data Controller, may have access to the Data. The updated list of Data Processors can always be requested from the Data Controller.

6. Legal basis for processing

The Professional's Office processes your personal data lawfully, where the processing is necessary for the performance of a contract with the User and/or the execution of pre-contractual measures, for the pursuit of the legitimate interests of the Data Controller or of third parties and of legal obligations.

7. Rights of the interested party

At any time you may exercise your rights towards the data controller, pursuant to articles 15 to 22 and art. 34 of the GDPR.

Among the rights recognized by the GDPR are those of:

- to request from the professional access to your personal data and information relating thereto; the
 rectification of inaccurate data or the integration of incomplete data; the deletion of personal data
 concerning you (upon the occurrence of one of the conditions indicated in Article 17, paragraph 1
 of the GDPR and in compliance with the exceptions provided for in paragraph 3 of the same
 article); the limitation of the processing of your personal data (upon the occurrence of one of the
 cases indicated in Article 18, paragraph 1 of the GDPR);
- to request and obtain from the professional in cases where the legal basis of the treatment is the contract or consent, and the same is carried out by automated means your personal data in a structured and machine-readable format, even in order to communicate such data to another data controller (so-called right to portability of personal data);
- to object at any time to the processing of your personal data in the event of special situations concerning you;
- revoke your consent at any time, limited to the cases in which the processing is based on your
 consent for one or more specific purposes and concerns common personal data (e.g. date and
 place of birth or place of residence), or special categories of data (e.g. data revealing your racial
 origin, political opinions, religious beliefs, state of health or sex life). The processing based on
 consent and carried out before the revocation of the same retains, however, its lawfulness;
- to complain to a supervisory authority (Guarantor Authority for the protection of personal data www.garanteprivacy.it).
